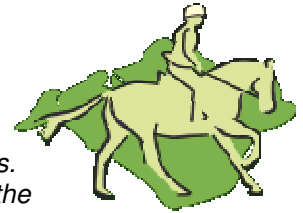


ISLE OF WIGHT RIDING CLUB SHOW JUMPING

Start 10am

Class 1 Mini Jumping: Max 12 inches. To encourage the younger and nervous riders. Riders any age. Led and unled.

Class 2 Starter Class: Jumps 18 inches (0.50m) Riders any age. Led or unled

There will be no doubles in Classes 1 & 2

Clear Round Jumps 2ft (0.60m)

Class 3 Introductory Jumping: Jumps 2ft (0.60m) in first round. Riders any age.

Class 4 Novice Jumping: Jumps 2ft 3" (0.70m) in first round. Riders any age.

Class 5 Open Novice Jumping: Jumps 2ft 6" (0.80m) in first round. Riders any age

Class 6 Intermediate Jumping: Jumps 2ft 9"(0.85m) in first round. Riders any age

Class 7 Open Jumping: Jumps 3ft - 3ft 3" (0.9m – 1.m) in first round. Riders any age

Class 8 Open Jumping: Jumps 3ft 3" - 3ft 6" (1m – 1.05m) in first round



Entry Fees: Entries on the day £10.00, **Members £8.00.** Clear round £5.00 First aid £3.00 per rider.

Conditions of Entry:

Riders must wear hats to EN1384, PAS015 or ASTM F1163, with chin strap securely fastened at all times when mounted.

The organisers and their stewards accept no liability for accident, loss or damage to any animal, person or property whilst on the show ground. No entry fees will be refunded unless a vet/doctors certificate to produced. The decision of the judge is final. The organisers reserve the right to cancel, add or amend any of the classes they think fit and to refuse entries.

The organisers have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and stewards at all time.

Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
